 - 2 weekends off per month
- Podiatric Surgeries
 - Inpatient, elective forefoot/rearfoot cases
- Podiatric Clinic
 - Increased clinic time from PGY-1, beginning of billing & coding education

PGY - 3

- Podiatric Medicine/Surgery
 - 52 wks
- Podiatric Hospital Call
 - 3 weeks of primary call
 - 3 out of 4 weeks of backup call
- Trauma Call
 - Senior on call for traumas
 - Primary resident on trauma cases
 - Rotates weekly between each
 PGY3
 - Rounding on inpatient trauma patients

- Podiatric Surgeries
 - Responsible for distribution of weekly surgical cases to all residents
 - First choices for weekly surgical cases
- Podiatric Clinic
 - 1 week per month clinic week
 - Main responsibility is learning inner workings of clinic during clinic week
 - Pre and postoperative surgical management in clinic
